1.	<p><u>Identification of the substance / preparation and the company</u></p> <p><u>Flightpath</u></p> <p>Microbial Developments Limited, Spring Lane North, Malvern Link, Worcestershire. WR14 1BU Tel: (01684) 580832/891055</p>
2.	<p><u>Composition / information on ingredients</u></p> <p>Freeze dried uncharacterised micro-organisms derived from healthy Specific Pathogen Free (SPF) avian intestinal viable bacteria.</p> <p>Carrier is maltodextrin</p>
3.	<p><u>Hazards identification</u></p> <p>Hazard warning not required.</p>
*4.	<p><u>First-aid measures</u></p> <p>After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water and soap. After eye contact rinse with plenty of water immediately.</p>
5.	<p><u>Fire-fighting measures</u></p> <p>Extinguishing media: sprayed water jet, foam, dry powder, CO₂. Fight fire in early stages if safe to do so. Wear respiratory protection equipment.</p> <p><u>Well ventilated areas</u> - Full face mask with a suitable filter combination of a type approved by the HSE.</p> <p><u>Enclosed premises</u> - Respirator with independent air supply. Contain firefighting water.</p>
*6.	<p><u>Accidental release measures</u></p> <p>Wear face mask with dust filter. Sweep up into a container and wipe up with a cloth dampened with disinfectant which should also be placed in the container. Seal the container. Wash cleaned area with disinfectant.</p>
7.	<p><u>Handling and storage</u></p> <p>Store in a refrigerator at 2 to 8°C when not in transit. Protect from light, raised temperature and humidity.</p>
8.	<p><u>Exposure controls / Personal protection</u></p> <p>In all cases a Laboratory coat or coveralls should be worn.</p> <p><u>Powder</u>: Persons with known respiratory disorders (e.g. Asthma) should avoid inhalation of the powder. A dust mask and impermeable gloves should be worn.</p> <p><u>In Liquid Form</u>: Ingestion of liquid should be avoided. A suitable mask (aerosol) and impermeable gloves should be worn.</p>
